

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

The staff at Platinum Dance Studio appreciates our parents & guardians and are privileged to educate your children through dance.

Below you will find our Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians, which outlines our parent expectations from the Platinum Dance Studio's Director and Staff.

Please read and sign the following:

Parents should be a positive role model at all dance classes and events. They should conduct themselves in a manner that is respectful and courteous to all.

Parents will support and respect the decisions made with regard to class placement and choreography based on the skill level of the student by studio's Director and Staff.

Parents shall support students and comply with their class time expectations as set out by the staff.
(please be on time for class)

Parents will be sure student's follow the dress code set by the studio's Director and Staff.

Parents understand that children exhibiting inappropriate behavior will be removed from the dance class. Parents agree to partner with Platinum Dance Studio staff to resolve behavioral issues immediately so that their child may return to class promptly.

Parents shall abstain from gossiping and any negative behavior. We encourage a positive atmosphere and strive to create an environment where your student will thrive and grow.

Parents shall refrain from critiquing any negative opinion about another parent, student, staff member or studio **both verbally or on social media.**

Parents must supervise their children while waiting in the studio's lobby to ensure that they do not disrupt classes, injure themselves or other dancers. Parents accept full responsibility for damages created by unsupervised children.

Parents who need to have a discussion with a staff member about their student, etc. will need to schedule a separate time when the discussion will occur. It **should not** be during classes or competition. We encourage communicating with the Director and Staff to keep a positive and supportive working relationship.

Parent's along with staff, should encourage students that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that student's will never feel defeated by the outcome of a competition or his or her performance.
